In the December 2014 issue, I reported that "The Search is On" for the new principal. Praise the Lord that the Council, at their meeting on 11 February 2015, confirmed the appointment of Rev Dr Philip Siew Tye Yau as the 4th Principal of STM for a term of four years, effective from 1 April

Rev Dr Philip Siew's early theological education was in Singapore at Trinity Theological College, followed by post-graduate studies (Old Testament) under the South East Asia Graduate School of Theology. Subsequently, he went on to Fuller Theological Seminary in USA and graduated with a PhD in Missions and Inter-cultural Studies.

Rev Dr Philip Siew has faithfully served in STM as a full-time faculty member since July 1999. Prior to teaching full-time in STM, he also taught part-time in 1988, 1991 and 1992. He has held the position of Director of Post-Graduate Studies from 2002 to 2010 and Director of Advanced Ministerial Studies from 2011 to the present. In 2004, he was also the Acting Dean of Studies.

Besides his great interest in theological education and ministerial formation, Rev Dr Philip Siew has vast ministe

rial, ecclesiastical and missional experiences from his 32 years of ministry in the Chinese Annual Conference of The Methodist Church in Malaysia.

Please support and pray wholeheartedly for Rev Dr Philip Siew as he takes on the new responsibilities to lead STM forward in these exciting and challenging times.

# Institute of World Religions

**Towards understanding and transforming society.**

Since 2007, the Institute of World Religions (IWR) under the leadership of the first director Rev Dr Solomon Rajah, and later the second director Rev Dr Joseph Komar, sought to encourage Christians not only to understand Malaysia's multi-cultural and multi-religious aspects, but also to engage society in constructive ways.

Early public lectures in 2008 touched on issues such as Civilizational Islam, Conversion and Apostasy, the state of the Malaysian judiciary, Constitutional reform, and other issues of public concern.

In 2015, Rev Dr Sivin Kit became the third director of IWR. Since taking over the leadership of IWR, a series of public lectures and workshops were organised in collaboration with

churches and other organisations. These collaborations reflect our renewed focus towards understanding the current Malaysian reality and support for Christian participation in transformative actions.

By now, although earlier themes continue to be important, the experience of Malaysians through two significant general elections in 2008 and 2013 has heightened the social and public consciousness of citizens in general. Furthermore, the debates over religious controversies and ethno-religious issues, especially under new media conditions, have intensified in the public sphere.

On 4 January 2015, Bishop Prof. Bedford-Strohm, a German public theologian spoke on "Prophetic Witness and Public Discourse in contemporary societies" at Luther Centre, PJ. CCM General Secretary Rev Dr Hermen Shastri then responded with reflections how Malaysians struggle to make their voice heard in recent years. The event was well attended with more than 80 participants. In response to questions from the audience, the speakers further highlighted the challenge of balancing speaking truth to power with engaging in dialogue with those who pursue the common good.

A workshop on "Violence in Abrahamic Religions" was held at the CCM Ecumenical Centre on 31 January 2015. Both Rev Dr Anthony Loke and Dr Patricia Martinez showed how

On 14 March 2015, IWR supported an initiative organised by Citizens' Network for a Better Malaysia (CNBM) where Rev Dr Joseph Komar (STM) discussed "the Divine Order for Ethnic Diversity". Other resource persons for the event were Dr Denison Jayasooria and Dr Helen Ting, both from Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM).

In the wake of current concerns over the plight of Christians in the Middle East, the IWR also organised a special public lecture "Keeping the Faith" on 23 March 2015 with Prof. Mark Swanson from the Centre for Christian-Muslim Engagement for Peace and Justice, Lutheran School of Theology at Chicago. Former Secretary General Eugene Yapp drew inspiration from the lecture to reflect on what "keeping the faith" means in Malaysia



Since the beginning of 2015, encouraging signs for IWR were not only support from Church leaders for its work, but also interest shown from concerned Christians,

religious resources may be used or abused in specific socio—historical circumstances. Dr Loke walked the 70 plus participants through difficult themes of violence and war in the Book of Judges and key Old Testament narratives such as Abraham's Sacrifice of Isaac; for her session, Dr Martinez raised a key question, "Whose Jihad?" Both ably approached their respective topics based on solid scholarship with rigour, respect, and a close contextual sensitivity to the Malaysian scenario.

# TEE: THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO **MARK**

It was announced on STM website well ahead of the closing date, that "the class is full and enrolment is now closed!" The module Interpreting New Testament (Mark) was held over two weekends in Jan 2015 and it was packed with 42 enthusiastic students, led by the spirited lecturer Rev Dr Lim Kar Yong. During the first weekend, Rev Dr Lim repeatedly urged the students to read the entire Gospel of Mark in one sitting, rather than a chapter per day. By doing so, we had a good grasp of the message and life of

Jesus as written in the Gospel of Mark. This gospel may be the shortest of the four gospels, however it is an action-packed gospel displaying the powerful ministry of Jesus. Throughout the two weekends, Rev Dr Lim traveled with us (with two large maps) the journey that Jesus walked through as depicted in the Gospel of Mark. The lecturer challenged us to imagine ourselves there with Jesus, and asked us how would we respond to each troublesome event. He also explained to us Biblical themes and historical

meanings of each text. Now we have a better grasp of the land that Jesus had walked and His story has come alive.

We were also taught to appreciate the distinctiveness of the Gospel of Mark in comparison with the other Gospels. In particular, he highlighted that we should not attempt to harmonize the four gospels. The two weekends were indeed enlightening, educative as well as entertaining!

## 神学院退修会 STM Retreat

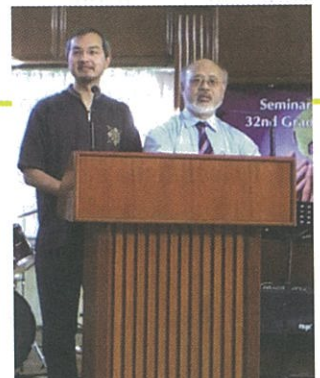

we need to remember 'the call of love' that the Lord Jesus has invited us to respond to (John 21:15-19); as the Father has sent Jesus into the world, likewise Jesus also sends us into the world (John 17:13-19); in the midst of the storm, we continue to trust in God (Mark 4:35-41); to be a disciple of Jesus, we must follow Jesus till the end -- regardless how much it might cost us (Luke 14:25-33). Finally, the retreat concluded with worship and Holy Communion.
