STM is an active member school of The Association of Theological Education in South East Asia (ATESEA). When ATESEA was first established in 1957, one of her aims was "to set guidelines and standards of theological education and to provide accreditation services to member-institutions and to others requesting it". Once in a few years, the ATESEA Accreditation Commission will send a team of scholars and senior administrators to visit the member seminaries and to conduct an accreditation exercise to ascertain that high standards are kept and maintained. A few years after the inception of STM in 1979, ATESEA conducted the first accreditation exercise for our BTh, BD, and MDiv degrees. Since then, STM has been able to continue to maintain a high standard in theological education and relevant ministerial training for Christian leaders in this country and for the neighboring countries.

For the year 2012, STM is one of the seminaries selected for the accreditation exercise of our main theological degree programs. To prepare ourselves for the accreditation visit, four documents were prepared and updated. Firstly, the Self-Study Report which is a critical self-examination for the school. The report, which is to be submitted three months before the actual visit, contains the basic data of our faculty, student, staff, curriculum, library, finance, council, management, physical plants, etc. Throughout the process, we are encouraged to critically think through issues and to plan for the future strategic development of the seminary. 



As Rev Dr James Dainty was visiting Malaysia, we took the opportunity to ask him to share his wide experience as a minister of God with us at STM and also at the CTEE centre. 

Rev Dr Tan Jin Huat's Latest Book

Planting an Indigenous Church: The Case of the Borneo Evangelical Mission

The publication of this book is a welcome addition to the scholarly literature in the history of Christianity in Southeast Asia, in particular, Sarawak. According to Professor Brian Stanley, Professor of World Christianity in the University of Edinburgh, this work breaks new ground in some important respects.

The story of the Borneo Evangelical Mission (BEM) and the Sidang Injil Borneo (SIB) highlights the importance of intentional mission policy and its sustained implementation for the development of an indigenous church. Having a clearly defined exit policy provided the necessary impetus for the BEM to plant a church which was



able to stand on its own two feet. There have been a number of contextual factors, such as the administrative policies of the Brooke government and the changing political situations in Sarawak and Malaysia that threatened to limit the growth of the SIB. However, the ability of the indigenous leaders to take ownership of the SIB have enabled them to negotiate these challenges in such a manner that has made it the most significant indigenous church in Malaysia.

In short, this work is a pioneering study of the origins and development of Malaysia's most significant indigenous church, the SIB.

Celebrating 400 Years of the Malay Language Bible



On March 2-3, STM, together with the Bible Society of Malaysia, successfully organised the historic event in Celebrating 400 years of the Malay Language Bible. The Gospel of Matthew was first translated by the Dutch tradesman, A. C. Ruyl, in 1612, only a year after the King James Version Bible was published. Its subsequent publication in 1629 was also very significant historically, as it marked the earliest translation of a portion of the Bible in a non-European language ever published.

The event, held at the campus of STM and Trinity Methodist Church, Petaling Jaya, on March 2 and 3 respectively, witnessed the presentation of various papers highlighting issues related to the translation and distribution of the Bible. At the same time, testimonies from those who were involved in the translation and reviewing the Malay Language Bible were also heard. Finally, a celebration and thanksgiving service remembering God's faithfulness in preserving the Bible and honouring those involved in the Malay Language Bible marked the climax of the 2-day event.

For the purpose of the accreditation visit, an in-house English version of the Catalogue was prepared for the team.

Thirdly, the Standard Operating Procedures for the Council and the Faculty Handbook was produced in order to strengthen the administration and corporate management of the seminary. Since seminary training for pastors and church workers is in a context of "education", visionary leadership and efficient management are vital and the STM Council and the Council Committees have been very active and supportive of this vision in the past.

Fourthly, the Staff Handbook is also in the final process of editing and publication. Our intention is to improve on the areas of management, accountability, and governance among the staff and faculty of the seminary.

During the accreditation visit from 15-17 February 2012, the team members were allocated time to interview the faculty, the student representatives, the alumni, and the council. The exchanges between the team and the seminary provided a wonderful learning experience. As we know, external accreditation is an important tool for educational bodies to maintain high standards. With the accreditation exercise provided by ATESEA (and ATA alike), theological seminaries are fully conscious of the expectations and demands of the churches, fellow Christian educators, and academicians. Therefore, theological seminaries, just as any other institutions of higher learning, are committed to provide the best form of education and wholistic training. As Christians, we will also add the words "and by the grace of God".

Endnote: The Accreditation Team of three scholars and senior administrators who visited STM was pleased with the progress of the seminary. They were assisted by three non-official members who had just visited two other seminaries. Their report will be submitted to the ATESEA Accreditation Commission and the Executive Committee for decision by the end of March. We will publish the official report in the June issue of the Berita STM.

第四份文件是"职员手册"。这份文件正在最后的修订和出版阶段。我们盼望藉此提升各个领域的行政管理、问责机制以及同工和讲师之间的配搭关系。

当评审团于2012年2月15-17日到访本院时,他们有机会与讲师、学生代表、校友,及董事会面和交谈。此交流为我们提供了许多学习的机会。众所公认,外部评审是确保教育机构保持高学术水平的重要渠道。因此,不论是"东南亚神学教育协会"(ATESEA)或"亚洲神学协会"(ATA)所提供的评审都大大提醒神学院要常常自我评估是否达标——不仅是内部运作顺畅,更是能够"生产"有能力满足教会各层面需求的"产品"。因此,神学院与其他高等教育学府一样都致力于提供最优质的教育和全方位的培训。当然,身为基督徒,我们不能忘记要"靠着上帝的恩典"。

备注:到访马来西亚神学院的评审团对于本院的进展感到满意。这个评审团由三位学者和高级行政人员组成;同时,有三位非官方成员与他们同行并协助他们。前来本院前,他们已经到访了另外两所神学院。他们的评审报告将提呈给东南亚神学教育协会的评审委员会和执行委员会于三月底做最后决定。我们将会在下一期的院讯报导这份官方报告。(刘聪赐译)
