The Principal's Message 院长的信息

Theological Education Is Costly

Theological education is significant and strategic because it equips God's people for ministry. It will build up the body of Christ – the Church, and who in turn will effectively reach out to the world to transform it with God's love and the good news of Christ. Nevertheless, it is costly! To be effective, it needs all kinds of power – spiritual, human, material and financial. Although we rely on God wholeheartedly to supply all these powers, God often supplies them through His people at large.

Spiritual power comes from the Holy Spirit, the gospel and the Word of God! It also comes through prayer! There is power through prayer!

People see God every day, but they just do not recognise Him - Pearl Bailey




