## Dr D. Michael Crow:

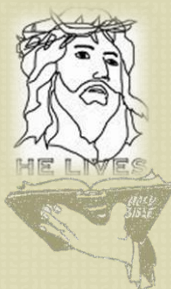


PhD

Dr Michael holds a PhD in Intercultural Studies (cross-cultural leadership) and has written on 'Spiritual Authority across Cultures: Leadership, Culture and the Holy Spirit'. He and his wife, Katie have served as missionaries since 1975.

They founded Bethany School of Missions (Singapore) for training Asian missionaries in 1988. In 1998, Mike & Katie joined Church Resource Ministries (CRM).

In 2008, Mike began a new ministry within CRM called J-Mentors (Jesus-in-Context: Multiplying Jesus Mentors) which aims to mentor leaders in East Asia through the life of Jesus in his first-century context, to better know and serve Him in contemporary contexts today. In Oct 2010 both Mike & Katie moved to East Asia to launch J-Mentors and train counselors in the regions.



## COURSE DESCRIPTION

Research has shown that teaching alone accomplishes 22% change in people's behavior – **at best**. However, **the exact same content** coupled with coach-mentoring accomplishes up to 88% behavioral transformation. Mentoring is FOUR TIMES more effective than teaching alone!

We see this in Jesus' own ministry. The Church was not founded by the 5,000, though they saw signs and wonders and ate miraculous bread at his 3-day Power Seminar. A Power Seminar for the Many – taught by Jesus Himself! – was not enough. He did not entrust the founding of the Church to the Many, but to the Few He called, mentored and empowered by the Spirit. Through those Few – the Twelve – rather than the Many, Jesus turned the world upside down. What can we learn from His model today?

This course invites experienced Servants of God to use the curriculum of Jesus-in-Context (re to English M.Min syllabus for May 2012 module) to create mentoring tools and processes aimed at 88% transformation. This course will not **tell** you how to mentor in your context. It will **guide** you as **you** create a mentoring program appropriate for your own context based on the life of Jesus. Compare notes and learn from fellow classmates as you generate creative new mentoring approaches to multiply leaders around you and see how Jesus-in-Context can impact your own life & ministry today (no prior courses required; some pre-work is necessary).
