Jesus-in-Context

What would life look like if we were Jews living in the time of Jesus? What would we simply **know** about the history, politics, economics and religious currents in Galilee or Judea? What would be in the back of our minds when Jesus walked into towns? In that social context, the things Jesus said and did were almost always explosive. What might our own reaction be toward Jesus, if we had lived in that day?

This course seeks to recreate the narrative scenarios of key events through the life of Jesus in his first-century context, in order to (a) better contemplate and know him in our own spiritual formation, and (b) more holistically reflect and live out what Jesus might say and do through us in our own contexts today.

This course explore how Jesus-in-His-Context shapes our relationship with Jesus-in-My-Context today.

About the lecturer:

Dr. D. Michael Crow holds a Ph.D in Intercultural Studies (cross-cultural leadership) and has written on 'Spiritual Authority across Cultures: Leadership, Culture and the Holy Spirit'. He and his wife, Katie have served as missionaries since 1975.

They founded Bethany School of Missions (Singapore) for training Asian missionaries in 1988. In 1998, Mike and Katie joined Church Resource Ministries (CRM).

In 2008, Mike began a new ministry within CRM called J-Mentors (Jesus-in-Context: Multiplying Jesus Mentors) which aims to mentor leaders in East Asia through the life of Jesus in his first-century context, to better know and serve Him in contemporary contexts today.

In Oct 2010 both Mike and Katie moved to East Asia to launch J-Mentors and train counselors in the region.
