### Notes on Christian Theology I (CT1) and II (CT2) as Core courses in TEE.

From 2011 onwards, the above two core theology courses will take the form of any two of the following theology courses - **Introduction to Theology and the Doctrine of God, Christology and Soteriology, Pneumatology and Anthropology and Ecclesiology and Eschatology**. CT1 and CT2 will no longer be offered for TEE. Students who are on the MCS or DipCM track will need to have completed the study of **any 2** of the four courses to fulfill your core Christian theology requirement. Likewise, those on the grad DipCS or CertCM will be required to have completed the study of **any 1** of the four courses available. For those of you who have completed both CT1 and CT2, you do not need to take any more theology courses as **core** requirement. Those who have not completed your Christian theology requirement/are half way there can consult us at TEE on how to proceed, if you are uncertain.

Basically, this is part of the faculty's decision to align the MCS program to better reflect a curriculum that will fit as seamlessly as possible to the more advance/higher Master of Divinity program.
