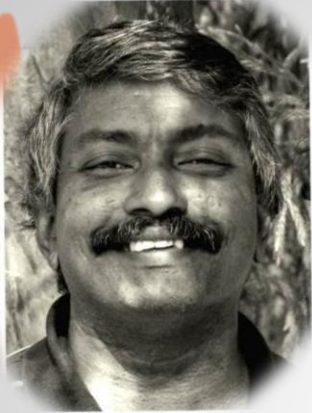
Church History 1

Course Description:

This course is designed to introduce students to the historical origins and development of the Church from the time just after the apostles to the medieval period, or the time just before the Reformation, covering approximately 1500 years of Church History. This survey will provide much information about how the church dealt with numerous issues of faith and order as the growing church had to deal with problems both from within and without. The spread of the church over different cultures and continents created much diversity as well as conflicts and tensions and many new movements, theologies and personalities arose to deal with them. Looking through history and seeing how the church met some of these challenges may give us some clues on how to handle them today, partly because some of the conflicts arising between Christianity and other religions date back to this time.
