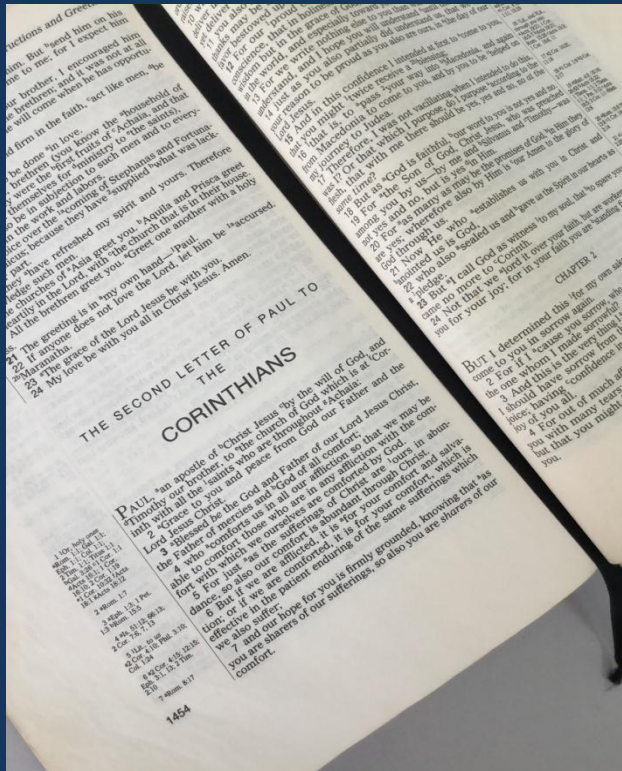
Theology of Minister and Ministry

A primary focus of this module will be Paul's understanding of the minister and ministry in his Second Epistle to the Corinthians. Paul had planted the Church in Corinth and had stayed on to minister to the young Christians there. With time, however, Paul was embroiled in an increasingly complex, difficult and almost volatile relationship with the Corinthian Christians. Misunderstood, questioned, and challenged by them, Paul launched a vigorous defence in this epistle of his own apostleship, integrity, motive, desire, and ministry. In the process, we are given a glimpse of Paul as a

minister of Christ, and how he views his own ministry. Students will also examine the ministry of Jesus and the lives and ministries of various pastors down through the centuries to derive pertinent ministry principles which, together with Paul's biblical-theological emphases, will hopefully reinforce what should be a robust and relevant theology of minister and ministry today.

Rev Dr Ong Meng Chai has served as pastor of Faith EFC, Kuala Lumpur (1986-1994, 2000-2006), and Tollington Park Baptist Church, London, United Kingdom (2006-2009). He trained at the London Theological Seminary and has a PhD in Theology (King's College London). He is a full-time lecturer at STM (Seminari Theoloji Malaysia) where he teaches Christian Theology and Philosophy of Religion. He is married to Sandra and they have a son.
